Dr. Lubiatowski, MD, PhD is the Medical Director of the Rehasport Clinic in Poznań, Poland, where he specializes in surgery of the upper extremity. He is also the head of the Traumatology and Sports Biomechanics Laboratory at Poznań University of Medical Sciences. He is past President of the Polish Orthopedic Society and a Program Director for the European Society for Surgery of the Shoulder and Elbow (ESSSE). He is a graduate of Poznań University of Medical Sciences with an impressive list of

international fellowships that includes the Cleveland Clinic, University of Edinburgh, Pittsburgh University, Rockford Orthopedic Associates, and the prestigious International Travelling Fellowship of the ESSSE. He enjoys travel, windsurfing, running, and has recently taken up golf. His lovely wife Beata will be joining him at our meeting.



Dr. Strafun, MD, PbD is a Senior Researcher in the Research Institute of Traumatology and Orthopedics of the National Academy of Medical Sciences (NAMS) of Ukraine, where he specializes in Microsurgery and Reconstructive Surgery. He is a graduate of the National Medical University in Kyiv, Ukraine, with post-graduate qualifications from the NAMS of Ukraine. He is a member of the Ukrainian Society of Orthopedic Surgeons, the Ukrainian Society of Arthroscopy, and the European Society for Surgery of the Shoulder

and Elbow (ESSSE). He has close to 100 articles, abstracts, and other papers in both Ukrainian and international journals, as well as several patents. He has served as a guest instructor and presenter at multiple European courses and meetings on shoulder and elbow surgery – including several recent meetings focusing on the treatment of war injuries.
